Later, we visit Ushiku Great Buddha which is one of the tallest statues in the world and at 120 m is the tallest Buddhist statue in Japan. Proceed for lunch. Step into the heart of traditional Japan with a captivating Kimono Experience and cultural stroll through the vibrant streets of Asakusa, one of Tokyo's oldest and most charming districts. Later Head to one of the world's tallest towers — the iconic Tokyo Skytree. Wrap up your day at the famous Shibuya Scramble Crossing, the busiest pedestrian intersection in the world. Next, we visit Nara Deer Park, where you can interact with hundreds of freely roaming deer, often regarded as “Messengers of God,” and explore Todaiji Temple, renowned for its Daibutsuden (Big Buddha Hall), which was once the world’s largest wooden building. In the evening, we visit Shinsaibashi - one of the most famous shopping streets in Osaka and Japan.</p>

After a poignant visit, return via bullet train.</p>

Payment Terms:

1. Booking Deposit
