- **Oslo City Exploration:** Karl Johans Gate, Aker Brygge waterfront, Vigeland Park, Holmenkollen Ski Jump, FRAM Museum, Folk Museum, and an Oslo Fjord Cruise.

  - Bergen Railway (Oslo ? Myrdal).
  - Flåm Railway (Myrdal ? Flåm) with a stop at **Kjosfossen Waterfall**.

Begin exploring the city with a visit to the Karl Johans Gate for shopping and cafés. In the evening, stroll along the Aker Brygge waterfront and enjoy dinner overlooking the Oslo Fjord on your own . Overnight at Oslo.</p>

Take a sightseeing tour by coach, visiting Vigeland Park and stopping at the famous Holmenkollen Ski Jump for photos. Then, tour the FRAM Museum, which talks about Norway's polar exploration, and the Folk Museum. Then head out into the Oslo Fjord to enjoy a cruise around the idyllic coastal region. Dinner on own. Overnight stay at Oslo.</p>

The ride from Oslo takes you through changing landscapes—from urban surroundings to dense forests, serene lakes, and dramatic mountain scenery. 13:03 – Arrival at Myrdal Reach Myrdal Station, a remote mountain junction situated 867 meters above sea level. Myrdal is known for its rugged alpine landscapes and is the gateway to the famous Flåm Railway. 13:15 – Departure from Myrdal on the Flåm Railway Board the iconic Flåmsbana (Flåm Railway), often described as one of the steepest and most spectacular train journeys in the world. In just under an hour, the train descends 20 km through dramatic mountain terrain, lush valleys, cascading waterfalls, and picturesque villages. A photo stop is usually included at the stunning Kjosfossen Waterfall. 14:05 – Arrival at Flåm Arrive in Flåm, a charming fjord-side village surrounded by towering mountains and the deep waters of the Aurlandsfjord (a branch of the Sognefjord). Afternoon/evening at leisure in Flåm Enjoy time at your own pace. Optional Tour: Fjord walks along the waterfront and nearby hiking trails for breathtaking views. A visit to the Ægir Brewery &amp; Pub, a local microbrewery styled like a Viking longhouse, perfect for tasting craft beers and Nordic-inspired dishes. Exploring the Flåm Railway Museum to learn more about the engineering behind this world-famous train line. Optional Tour Fjord activities such as below (time permitting). Kayaking Cycling or a short cruise Overnight stay at Flam.</p>

Guests will have leisure time here to enjoy lunch, take a short stroll, or simply relax and soak in the alpine atmosphere. Gondola round trip : Enjoy a scenic ride on the gondola and take in panoramic views of the surrounding mountains and the town of Voss 17:00 – Departure from Voss by train Board the train for the final leg of the journey toward Bergen. 18:17 – Arrival at Bergen Reach Bergen, the gateway to the fjords, known for its colorful Bryggen Wharf, historic charm, and vibrant cultural scene. Evening at leisure and overnight stay at Bergen.</p>

Before you head back, hop aboard a ferry to experience Hardangerfjord and the Vestland countryside. ## Payment Terms:

### 1. Booking Deposit

- Amount: 25% - 30% of total package cost\*
- Due: At the time of booking confirmation
- Purpose: To secure your seat on the tour, hotel rooms, transport, guides, etc.

### 2. Final Payment

- Amount: Remaining balance
- Due: 30 days before departure

### 3. Last-Minute Bookings

- 100% payment due at the time of booking if travel is within 30 days.

#### **Payment Methods**

- Bank Transfer / NEFT / RTGS
- Credit Card (with a surcharge of 2.5%)
- Payment Gateway Link (if online)
- UPI / Digital Wallets (as per regional convenience)

#### **Cancellation Policy:**

- More than 31 days before departure: Deposits and payments are refundable (except for domestic airline tickets, which may have separate terms).
- 30 to 21 days before departure: A 25% booking fee per person is charged.
- 20 to 8 days before departure: A 50% booking fee per person is charged.
- 7 days or less before departure: 100% of the booking fee is charged.
