Then you will proceed to the Peradeniya Botanical Gardens which is a paradise for nature lovers. This beautiful flower Eden is restored with over 300 different varieties of orchids, other spices, medicinal plants and Palm trees. Every year more than 1.2 million people are enchanted by the beauty of these 147 acre flower gardens. Later in the afternoon visit Gem shop. cultural show in the evening, where traditional Kandyan dancers perform their centuries-old dancing routines.
